ENJOY A 2.55+ MILE LOOP OF PROFESSIONALLY ENGINEERED TRAILS THAT LEAD TO A SPECTACULAR VIEW OF MT. SHASTA.

- Summit-Stream Mainline / 1.1 miles / 2.2 miles round trip
- Easy Extension / 0.93 miles / 1.86 miles round trip
- Cabin Connector / 0.18 Mile
- Nest Connector / 0.3 Mile
- Lodge Connector / 0.11 Mile
- Gravel Road

Elevation Gain 310 feet

The McCloud area is home to almost anything an outdoor enthusiast might want to see or do. Within 10 miles of here you can visit the three McCloud River Falls, the Cattle Camp swimming hole, Lake McCloud, the McCloud Golf Course and the Mt. Shasta Ski Park. You can also stay close to home and hike our private trail network to catch a spectacular view of Mt. Shasta up at the "Summit Vista."

A bit further afield you can experience Mt. Shasta, Burney Falls, the Castle Crags, Black Butte, the majestic Eddy's, Shasta Lake, Shasta Caverns or even tour Shasta Dam. Here are a couple of things to remember during your stay with us.

- **NO OUTDOOR FIRES** of any type. We live in the middle of fire country and an errant cigarette or improperly doused campfire can have catastrophic consequences. You are welcome to grill on the deck, but please take care to manage your flame! As a reminder, we do not allow smoking inside our property. **ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- You are in bear country! It would not be uncommon to spot a black bear along the road, up on the trails or in the meadow. These are not tame animals and will most likely run away once they are aware of your presence. That said, always be alert and never attempt to approach or feed a bear. Also, be aware that you never want to find yourself between mama bear and her cubs! Just use common sense and be mindful that you're in wildlife territory! Also, PLEASE be sure to move the big trashcans indoors once you've placed any refuse in them. There is nothing worse than having to pick up garbage in the meadow the morning after the bears have had a party! At the cabin, please keep the ground floor windows closed and locked at night as well.
- At the cabin, we do not have air conditioning. This is a non-issue for 350 days out of the year but when local temperatures push above 95 degrees, it can start to feel warm - especially upstairs. When it's hot, we keep things comfortable by keeping the windows open and using the fans throughout the day. Remember, if it is 95 outside now, it will be down to 60 in a couple of hours. Be sure to remember where you put that hoodie!
- When traveling the dirt road to the Cabin and Lodge properties, **PLEASE MAINTAIN A SPEED OF NO MORE THAN 10 MPH**. This is required by our community to preserve our roadway and minimize dust. Your consistent cooperation with our speed limit is greatly appreciated!

On the reverse, please find a map of our private trail network. You are welcome to take this with you when you depart as a souvenir of your stay with us. The Stream-Summit Mainline with the Easy Extension option trail is our longest route and great for hikers of all ages at only a 5% average grade. By itself, the Summit-Stream Mainline is shorter, a bit steeper and a bit more challenging with an average 10% grade. Together, our trails combine for a roughly 2.55 mile loop that takes about 50-75 minutes to complete depending on your pace. At the top, be sure to spend some time up at the Summit Vista enjoying the spectacular view of Mt. Shasta!
